WHAT MAKES US DIFFERENT?

Reporting, publishing and training haven't been our only concerns. Rather, we have tried to maintain the institution's intellectual autonomy and have challenged the consensual myths, socio-political stereotypes and super-structures of dominance in the society by introducing discourse around matters of sensitivity for the state and society. For instance;

- 1. The idea of connectivity between two parts of the divided Jammu and Kashmir State was induced in the larger political discourse of region. The activists in CPDR helped in formation of cross-LoC joint groups of traders, youth and researchers.
- 2. In an attempt to establish liaisons between public institutions and common masses; CPDR has conducted seminars and workshops as well as published extensive recommendatory reports and research papers on constitutional reforms in AJK. Need assessment reviews and baselines studies on challenges of youth in AJK and Gilgit-Baltistan are also conducted.
